

**François Gabbai** was born in France and studied in Bordeaux where he obtained a bachelor in 1990. The same year, he crossed the Atlantic to undertake his graduate work at the University of Texas at Austin with Alan Cowley. Upon completion of his Ph.D. in 1994, he received an Alexander von Humboldt fellowship and joined the group of Hubert Schmidbaur at the Technische Universität München as a postdoctoral fellow. He stayed in Munich for four years and ultimately received a Habilitation. In 1998, he joined Texas A&M University where he now holds the Arthur E. Martell Chair of Chemistry.

He is a member of the advisory board of several international journals and has served as an Associate Editor for *Organometallics* since 2011. He is a Fellow of the American Chemical Society, a Fellow of the Royal Society of Chemistry and the recipient of the 2009 North American Dalton Lectureship. He was also recognized in 2016 with the 2016 ACS F. Albert Cotton Award in Synthetic Inorganic Chemistry.
