

László T. Mika was born in 1976 Budapest, Hungary. He studied chemical engineering (University of Veszprém, Hungary) and chemistry (Eötvös University, Hungary) and received a PhD degree in organic- and organometallic chemistry from Eötvös University in 2010, under supervision of Prof. István T. Horváth. He worked as an assistant professor at Institute of Chemistry, Eötvös University until 2012, when he joined to the Department of Chemical and Environmental Process Engineering, Budapest University of Technology and Economics as an associate professor. Since 2016 he is the head of Department and Laboratory of Catalysis. His research activity documented by ca 40 scientific papers covers different areas of green chemistry (biomass conversion, applications of alternative reaction media for catalysis including designing of new catalytic systems). He received the Janos Bolyai Scholarship of Hungarian Academy of Sciences (2014–2017), József Varga Scholarship (2017–2019) and the Bolyai Plaque (2018).
