

Vito Capriati is Full Professor of Organic Chemistry at the University of Bari (I). He has been Visiting Scientist at the Ohio State University (USA) (2001) and Visiting Professor at the Göthenburg University (Sweden) (2003). He is co-founder of the academic spin-off “Synchimia srl” and Director of Interuniversity Consortium CINMPIS since 2016. Main research interests revolve around the chemistry of highly polarised organometallic compounds, the synthesis and reactivity of new heterocycles, asymmetric catalysis, and the development of new sustainable chemical processes using unconventional reaction media (e.g., water and deep eutectic solvents). He was the recipient of the CINMPIS Prize “Innovation in Organic Synthesis” (2009) and of the Award of the Italian Chemical Society (Organic Division) for “Mechanistic and Theoretical Aspects of Organic Chemistry” (2014). Since 2019, he is Fellow of the Royal Society of Chemistry. He is author of over 140 papers, 7 book chapters, co-editor of “Lithium Compounds in Organic Synthesis from Fundamentals to Applications” (2014), and editor of various Special Issues.
